Heartsaver FACTS/AED	Adult only <i>No child or infant</i>	<b>No</b>
ACLS Provider	Adult VF/VT first 10 minutes	<b>No</b>
PALS Provider	Infants and Children	<b>No</b>

BCLS	Adult, Infant, Child ( <b>this is an online course that does not require hands- on skills testing</b> )	<b>No – online courses w/no skills testing are not acceptable</b>
